SCPS Flower Show Judges 2022

What does it take to judge a flower show? We were lucky to have six experts this year to judge. SCPS has a long-standing partnership with the San Diego Center for the Blind. Judges with visual impairments who are not biased by either the look of the flower or insider knowledge of the flower the name tells experienced growers, such as seedling developer or the flower's reputation, judge our two fragrance sections, IV and IX. Thanks to Jessica Healy, Luna Edwards, Joni Meir, and this year's enthusiastic volunteer, Virginia Martin, for continuing our collaboration.

As for the other seven categories, we turn to experienced plumerians. Maggie Forys has been growing plumeria in San Diego for at least 15 years. She served as a board member for 7 years and originated and created the annual SCPS calendar contest.

Diana Holland has been a SCPS member since 2005, served on the SCPS board for six years, and has registered her seedling "Diana's Rainbow" with the PSA. She was a Botanical Fellow in Horticulture at San Diego Zoo in 1980s and a Botany major at Pomona college, and went with the International Plumeria Society in 2009 to Bali to study and collect plumeria. She is awed by the "the colors and varieties of plumeria that are available since [she] started [her] collection in 1985."

Jean Thielmann resides in Santa Barbara, Ca. She has been growing plumeria for approximately forty-seven years. According to her husband, she has never met a plumeria she didn't like, and wanted to take home.
